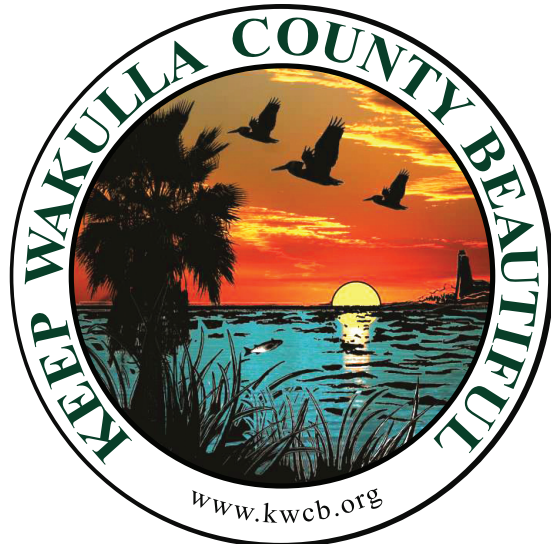

- Household cleaners – such as oven cleaners, wood and metal cleaners and polishers, toilet bowl cleaners, disinfectants, drain openers.
- Old Prescriptions
- Automotive products – such as oil and fuel additives, grease and rust solvents, carburetor and fuel injector cleaners, air conditioning refrigerants, starter fluids, body putty, antifreeze/coolant, contaminated motor oil, gasoline, diesel and kerosene.
- Home maintenance and improvement products – such as paint, paint thinners, paint strippers and removers, adhesives
- Lawn and garden products – such as herbicides, pesticides/ rodenticides, fungicides, wood preservatives.
- Electronics (anything that plugs into an electric outlet) – such as old computers, computer parts, DVD players, VCR's, radios, cellphones, satellite dishes, and other small appliances.
- Miscellaneous – all batteries such as lithium, alkaline, car and button batteries, fingernail polish remover, pool chemicals, photo processing chemicals, reactive material, aerosols/compressed gas, fluorescent bulbs and tubes.
